COUNCIL MEETING April 7, 2025

The City Council approved a contract to replace the roof at the Heritage Center.

A \$1,000 scholarship donation from CricHub Academy was accepted.

Several contracts for Environmental Resources projects were approved.

The Council approved a contract with CNH Architects for new fire station design services.

A public hearing was held and a contract was approved for the 2025 Street Reconstruction/Rehabilitation project.

The Council held a public hearing and approved the Spirit of Brandtjen Farm 25th preliminary plat and PUD amendment for seven new detached townhomes.

The Council approved the Lord of Life Townhomes preliminary plat, which consists of 24 townhomes adjacent to the Lord of Life church on Dodd Boulevard.
