City Watering Ordinance

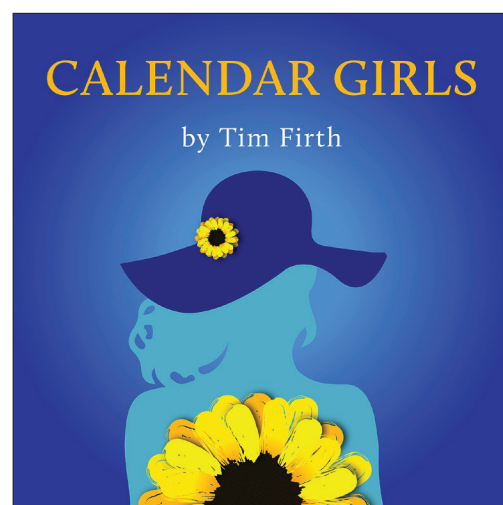
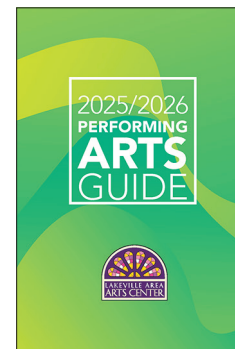
Odd/even and time-of-day watering restrictions are in effect now through September 30. Water only as needed on odd-numbered days if your house number ends in an odd number, or even-numbered days if your house number ends in an even number. Also, watering is not allowed between 11 a.m. and 5 p.m.—watering during the heat of the day wastes water due to evaporation. Go to LakevilleMN.gov for more information.

COUNCIL MEETING July 7, 2025

A preliminary plat was approved for Heritage Commons 10th Addition, at the northeast corner of Dodd Boulevard and County Road 50, for a Chipotle and Starbucks.

A conditional use permit was approved for Pickle in the Middle, an indoor pickleball facility to be located at 21300 Juniper Way (which is currently under construction).

The City Council approved an agreement with HGKi for development of the 2026-2036 Parks System Master Plan.

The City entered into a Joint Powers Agreement with Dakota County for sections of the North Creek Greenway and various roadway projects across the City.

The Council approved a final plat and conditional use permit for Crossroads East Third Addition, north of 175th Street and west of Glacier Way, for Lakeville Family Pet Clinic.
