



Lakeville Police Department Update

Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers completed a traffic accident report for a crash at 162nd Avenue West and Jaguar Avenue. One vehicle was towed after attempting to turn in front of a truck. The driver was cited for failure to drive with due care.
- Officers were dispatched to a report of a suspicious vehicle that showed up overnight at 16XXX East Lake Drive. The vehicle was running, had no plates, and the lock on the door was cut out. The vehicle was determined to be stolen from a nearby city. The vehicle was towed due to the other agency's direction.
- Officers responded to a crash involving three vehicles at Ipava Avenue and 190th Street West. A vehicle traveling eastbound failed to yield to a vehicle traveling northbound on Ipava Avenue, causing his car to crash into another vehicle waiting to go westbound. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield.
- A theft-from-vehicle report was completed following a report of a vehicle being rummaged through while parked near 5XXX 177th Street West. The victim's wallet, cash, credit cards, and ID were taken. Patrol is following up to obtain camera footage.
- Officers were dispatched to a past action theft report at 16XXX East Lake Drive. The victim reported that his vehicle was stolen from his driveway after being out of town and left the key fob inside the vehicle. The investigation is currently ongoing, but a reminder to always lock your doors and keep your keys and valuables in a secure location.
- A vehicle was stopped after a registration check was run and showed a prior stop with a male subject driving after revocation. The driver was confirmed to be the same male and was unable to provide a valid insurance card. The male was arrested for uninsured vehicle and driving after revocation and was transported to Dakota County Jail.
- Officers responded to a crash at 175th Street and Highview Avenue where a driver ran a stop sign and collided with another vehicle. Luckily, there were no injuries. The at-fault driver displayed signs of impairment and provided a preliminary breath test sample of .14 blood alcohol content. The at-fault driver was jailed for 3rd degree DWI and transported to Dakota County Jail.
- A citation was issued for failure to drive with due care, following a two-vehicle crash at Kenwood Trail and Jaguar Path. The at-fault driver failed to yield on a left turn resulting in a collision and minor injuries.
- Officers responded to a two-vehicle crash at 18XXX Cedar Avenue. The driver merged quickly from the right lane to the left, hitting the victim vehicle already traveling in the left lane. The driver was cited for improper lane use.
