### Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers observed a vehicle driving over the curb and conducting multiple lane use violations. A traffic stop was completed, and the driver was displaying signs of impairment. The standard field sobriety testing was conducted and the driver failed. They provided a preliminary breath test of .242 blood alcohol content and was subsequently jailed.
- Multiple officers responded to a report of heavy smoke inside the residence at XXX Juliet Drive. The Lakeville Fire Department also responded and extinguished the flames and luckily no injuries were sustained.
- Officers dealt with a shoplifter at 18XXX Kenrick Avenue for stealing \$210 worth of makeup. The suspect was cited and trespassed for a year.
- Community Service Officers located a lost golden retriever near 16XXX Estate Lane. They located the owners after and returned their dog after almost being impounded at Dakota Pet Hospital.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle stolen from the driveway overnight near 19XXX Huxley Avenue. The reporting party reported that the vehicle was left unlocked with the fob inside. The vehicle was recovered in a neighboring city with no obvious damage. A reminder to lock your vehicles and keep your keys in a secure location.
- A passerby called in a driving complaint for a vehicle which was parked temporarily, slumped over then started driving again. Officers stopped the vehicle, and the driver was displaying signs of impairment. The driver provided a DMT-g sample of .18 blood alcohol content and was arrested for DWI and transported to Dakota County Jail.
- Officers responded to a suspicious persons call involving a vehicle stuck on private property. The caller stated they could hear an engine revving and he believed the vehicle may be tearing up his yard. Officers arrived and observed the vehicle in the front yard and backed into a tree. The vehicle was running, the occupants were identified and the driver displayed signs of impairment. The driver provided a preliminary breath test of .225 and was placed under arrest for DWI and transported to Dakota County Jail.
- Officers responded to a theft from vehicle report at 10XXX 166<sup>th</sup> Street. The reporting party advised that two unlocked vehicles had been rummaged through and some items of value were taken. The investigation is ongoing, but this serves as a reminder to always lock your vehicle.
- Officers responded to the area of 8XXX 189<sup>th</sup> Street West after a report of a male pulling on car door handles. The suspect was not located and the investigation is ongoing.
