### Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- This week, officers responded to fourteen mental health crisis calls and twenty-three welfare checks. If you or someone you know is struggling or experiencing a crisis, please reach out – help is available 24/7.

- Officers conducted a traffic stop after a license plate check revealed the registered owner, who matched the driver's description, had a revoked driver's license. The driver was cited for driving after revocation and no insurance, and the vehicle was towed from the scene.
- A minor two-vehicle accident occurred at Cedar Avenue and 162<sup>nd</sup> Street where the at-fault driver struck the rear of another vehicle after mistakenly believing it was moving forward. The driver was cited for failure to drive with due care.
- A two-vehicle crash with minor injuries occurred at Kenyon Avenue and Kenwood Trail when the at-fault driver attempted to cross Kenwood Trail and failed to yield to oncoming traffic. The driver was cited for failure to yield.
- Officers conducted a license plate check on a vehicle traveling below the posted speed limit and discovered the driver had a cancelled-IPS license status and two active warrants. The driver was arrested and booked into the Dakota County Jail on the warrants.
- Officers cited and trespassed a suspect for the theft of goods from 17XXX Kenrick Avenue.
- Officers documented a two-vehicle accident at 185<sup>th</sup> Street and Kenyon Avenue where a semi-truck was attempting to change lanes and side-swiped a sedan. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to drive with due care.
- A traffic accident report was completed for a two-vehicle property damage crash at the roundabout at 185<sup>th</sup> Street and Kenwood Trail. The at-fault driver was cited for improper chance of course.
- Officers responded to the report of a slumper parked in the roadway blocking a driveway. Officers made contact with the driver and observed signs of impairment. The driver failed the standard field sobriety tests and provided a blood alcohol content sample of 0.15. He was arrested for DWI and transported to Dakota County Jail.
