### Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers stopped a vehicle for speed, and when they approached the vehicle, smoke came out of the window. The driver admitted to recent cannabis use and performed poorly on the standard field sobriety tests. The driver was taken into custody; a warrant was approved and one of our phlebotomist officers completed a blood draw. He was released to a sober party pending results.
- Another vehicle was stopped for failure to maintain their lane. The driver was displaying multiple signs of impairment. The driver completed the standard field sobriety testing and provided a preliminary breath test of .16 blood alcohol content. The driver was arrested for 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree DWI and was released to a sober party.
- Officers completed a traffic accident report at Kenwood Trail and 185<sup>th</sup> Street where one unit was driving too fast and struck the stopped unit in front of him. The at-fault driver was cited for careless driving.
- Officers responded to a two-vehicle crash at 215<sup>th</sup> Street West and Hamburg Avenue where the at-fault driver failed to yield to oncoming traffic when she attempted to cross 215<sup>th</sup> Street. She was cited for the stop sign violation and transported to Ridges with minor injuries.
- A vehicle was stopped for numerous lane use violations, and the driver was found to be displaying signs of impairment. The driver failed the standard field sobriety tests and provided a DMT sample of .19. The driver was charged with 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree DWI and transported to Dakota County Jail.
- Officers completed a traffic accident report for a property damage crash at 192<sup>nd</sup> Street and Kenwood Trail. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield, both vehicles were towed and one passenger sustained minor injuries.
- Officers responded to a single vehicle versus dog park fence. The driver reported they were on their phone and mistook the accelerator for the brake. The driver was cited for hands-free violation.
- Officers responded to a two-vehicle crash at Cedar Avenue and Lakeville Boulevard. One vehicle was traveling southbound and attempting to make a right turn when they looked to their left to check for traffic while accelerating and rear ended the other vehicle in front of them. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to drive with due care.
- A theft from vehicle report was completed at 16XXX Hyland Avenue where the reporting party advised their wallet was stolen from their unlocked vehicle. A reminder to always lock your vehicles and keep your valuables out of sight.
