Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Multiple officers responded to 20XXX Keokuk Ave on a report of a male who had been laying in the restroom for hours and was refusing to leave. The individual was located intoxicated and uncooperative. The male was placed under arrest for misdemeanor trespass and obstructing the legal process and was issued a trespass notice.
- Due to freezing rain and some slick road conditions, a large box truck slid into the semaphore at Dodd Blvd and CR 50. Luckily no injuries were sustained.
- Officers spoke with a victim of fraud who attempted to purchase a collectible Hot Wheels car through Facebook Marketplace. The victim sent payment to the seller but never received the item, and the seller ceased all communication. This serves as a reminder to use caution when purchasing items online through unverified sources.
- Officers stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation and observed five children in the backseat without car seats and buckles. The driver was showing signs of impairment from Cannabis and performed poorly on the standard field sobriety testing. A warrant for blood was approved and executed. The driver was released to his wife and charges are pending blood results.
- Officers stopped a vehicle with expired tabs as of January 2024. The driver was arrested for gross misdemeanor intent to escape tax.
- A traffic accident report was completed for a two-vehicle accident in the roundabout at 185th St W and Kenwood Trl. A rear end accident occurred due to one driver thinking the other was going to enter the roundabout and didn't.
- Officers completed a traffic accident report for a two-vehicle rear-end crash at Flagstaff Ave and 179th Street West. One vehicle stopped in the roundabout for a pedestrian, and the following vehicle failed to stop and collided with it. A reminder to remain alert for pedestrians, especially near crosswalks.
- Another traffic accident report was completed for a minor two-vehicle accident at Kenwood Trail and Dodd Blvd after one vehicle failed to obey the traffic light, colliding with the other. Luckily there were no injuries, and the at-fault driver was cited.
- Officers handled a theft from an unlocked vehicle near 17XXX Jersey Way. Unknown suspects had taken loose change and a jump pack, a reminder to always lock your vehicle and keep any valuables out of sight.
- A vehicle was stopped for speed and the driver was found to be driving after suspension and had no insurance. The driver was booked into Dakota County Jail.
