Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers responded to a vehicle fire on the ramp to southbound I-35 from County Road 50. The vehicle was found unoccupied, and Lakeville Fire Department arrived and extinguished the flames. Officers later contacted the driver, who reported hearing a “pop,” observed smoke coming from the engine, and left the area. No injuries were reported.
- Officers completed a traffic accident report for a two-vehicle crash at 162nd Street and Kenwood Trail. The at-fault driver initiated a left turn through the intersection and failed to yield to a vehicle with the right of way, resulting in a collision. One driver sustained minor injuries and was transported to Ridges Hospital. Both vehicles were towed due to damage, and the at-fault driver was cited.
- A two-vehicle crash occurred at 16XXX Dryden Ave where one driver was backing out of their driveway and didn't see the other vehicle coming. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield.
- Officers responded to a report of a slumper at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue involving an elderly driver parked for over an hour. The driver was breathing but minimally responsive. Officers gained access to the vehicle and determined the driver was experiencing very low blood sugar. The driver was transported to Ridges Hospital.
- A vehicle was stopped for multiple moving violations and displayed signs of impairment. The driver performed poorly on the standard field sobriety tests and provided a sample of .13 blood alcohol content and was transported to Dakota County Jail on DWI charges.
- Officers cited an individual at 18XXX Kenrick Ave after she failed to scan items at a self-checkout. She was stopped, cited and trespassed.
- During a traffic stop for speeding, officers noted indicators of alcohol impairment. The driver did not pass standardized field sobriety testing and provided a DMT breath sample of .08g/210L. The driver was taken into custody for DWI and later released to a sober individual.
- Officers later stopped another vehicle for speeding after observing driving conduct consistent with impairment. The driver showed signs of intoxication, failed field sobriety testing, and provided a DMT breath sample of .09g/210L. The driver was issued a citation and released to a sober party.
- Officers were dispatched to a vehicle stuck in a snowbank. Upon contact, the driver displayed obvious signs of impairment, performed poorly on standardized field sobriety tests, and provided a breath sample of .23 blood alcohol content. The driver was arrested for DWI and transported to Dakota County Jail.
- Officers and the Lakeville Fire Department responded to a vehicle fire at 21XXX Hamburg Avenue. Maintenance was being performed on a truck when staff reported hearing an explosion, which caused a fire that later spread to a second truck. No injuries were reported.
