Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers responded to a theft in progress at 20XXX Keokuk Ave. When the suspect was confronted by loss prevention, the suspect dropped the bag of merchandise and took off. Surveillance was reviewed and the suspect was identified and will be mailed a citation for misdemeanor theft.
- A traffic accident report was completed at 192nd St and Ileri Ave where the at-fault driver attempted to make a u-turn in the intersection and collided with another vehicle. The at-fault driver was cited for improper change of course.
- Officers responded to a disturbance at 17XXX Kenrick Ave where two men were in a verbal dispute over a parking spot which then escalated into a physical altercation. Each man involved was issued a citation for disorderly contact.
- A traffic stop was initiated due to the driver drifting over multiple lanes of traffic. The driver was displaying signs of impairment and performed poorly on the standard field sobriety tests. The driver provided a preliminary breath test of 0.179 BAC and was arrested for 3rd Degree DWI.
- Officers conducted an early morning traffic stop and found the driver to be impaired. The driver submitted to the standard field sobriety tests and provided a preliminary breath test of 0.18 BAC. The driver was subsequently booked at Dakota County Jail for 3rd Degree DWI.
- Officers located a vehicle that was displaying an active warrant. The driver was confirmed to be the registered owner and subsequently placed her in custody. The driver provided bail and was ultimately released and provided a new court date.
- Officers stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation and found the driver to have a Cancelled-IPS driving status. The driver was transported home and was charged via formal complaint.
- Officers observed a vehicle driving all over the road without headlights and stopped the vehicle. The driver was showing obvious signs of impairment and performed poorly on the standard field sobriety tests. The driver provided a preliminary breath test of 0.187 BAC and was arrested for 3rd Degree DWI.
- Multiple crashes occurred due to the winter storm. A reminder to slow down and plan ahead for extra drive time.
- Officers responded to a rear-end crash at Cedar Ave and Lakeville Blvd where the at-fault driver was cited for due care after following too closely.
