If you are not covered under a NPDES Construction Stormwater Permit administered by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA), an erosion and sediment control plan MUST be approved as part of the residential building permit application.

"Permittees must ensure a trained person will inspect the entire construction site at least once every seven (7) days during active construction and within 24 hours after a rainfall event greater than ½ inch in 24 hours," (NPDES Permit, Section 11.2).

The City of Lakeville reserves the right to request weekly inspection logs. The City of Lakeville may issue a STOP WORK ORDER; withhold building inspections; or, draw on securities/escrows to bring the site into compliance with the NPDES Construction Stormwater Permit (MN R 100001) or erosion and sediment control plan.
